**BANQUET VOTE: Weeks 8 & 9 only. CAST YOUR TEAM'S VOTE on the back of your score sheet. Eligible places are Tap Room, Long Lake, Nob Hill and Playtime.**

**PAPERWORK UPDATE:** Beginning with the Fall 2010 session, the board has agreed that any paperwork not postmarked by Friday of the same week of shoot will receive a 1 point penalty to that team. Captains should take this to mean the receipt of paperwork is very important to keep our handicaps accurate and the league running.

**POINTS SHOWN ON THE ROSTER:** You only get credit for the matches you actually shoot. If your team wins a forfeit point and your name is listed as the person winning the forfeit, you do NOT receive a point next to your name, but your team DOES receive the point. The reason for this is we affect your handicap each time we give the player a point—you do not want your handicap negatively or positively affected from winning a forfeit point.

**B&R PATCH:** Several people have noted the desire for a B&R patch. If someone wants to make an attempt at designing one, the board will entertain adding one.

**SOFT BREAK:** A reminder that if a soft break occurs (less than 4 balls hit a rail—or if the player misses the rack entirely), the same breaker will break. If the soft break occurs and a scratch happens (even if the entire rack is missed), the opponent receives the opportunity to break. It is very important to note the cue ball IS LIVE after crossing the head string. If you mis-cue and the cue passes the head string, DO NOT try to stop the cue. Let whatever may happen occur and determine from there who breaks based upon soft breaking rules (Rule 507).

**WATCHING THE HIT:** All players have the right to ask for an impartial party to watch a hit. The shooter should wait for the opponent to return with the impartial party before attempting the shot (see Example under Rule 404).

**8OB Patches and Stripes: Because we aren't delivering paperwork this session, all 8OB patches/stripes will be distributed at the banquet to anyone who earns one.**

- *Week 8-0 teams had score sheet errors. Be sure to check paperwork with your opponent.* Points will NOT be deducted for the first 4 weeks of play for score sheet errors (through week 5 if you have a bye in the first 4 weeks). If you do have an error in the first 4 weeks, you will receive a copy of that score sheet denoting the error. **Differences in the number of innings won due to incorrect addition will lose a point as a score sheet error (ie if you have a different number of innings than your opponent, you will not lose a point as a score sheet error).** *As a reminder, each team is still allowed 1 free score sheet error per session.*
